# Process Breakdown

1. Query college records to identify initial Universe Of Interest and create master spreadsheet for tracking and notes
2. Submit list to NSC Student Tracker to identify student enrolled elsewhere or received degree, remove matches from Universe
3. Conduct beta Degree Audit, determine Eligible, Potential and Neither groups
4. **Communicate with Eligibles to award degrees**
5. **Communicate with Potentials to create completion plans**

Policies to consider....

- College catalog years to be used
- Opt In/Opt Out policies
- Automated vs. manual degree audits
- Default vs. declared major
- Waivers, Substitutions, Exceptions
- Institutional funds available for scholarships
- Credit for Prior Learning policies
- Communication - Press Release, Radio, Brochure/Career Focus, Web/Social Media, Faculty/Staff Awareness



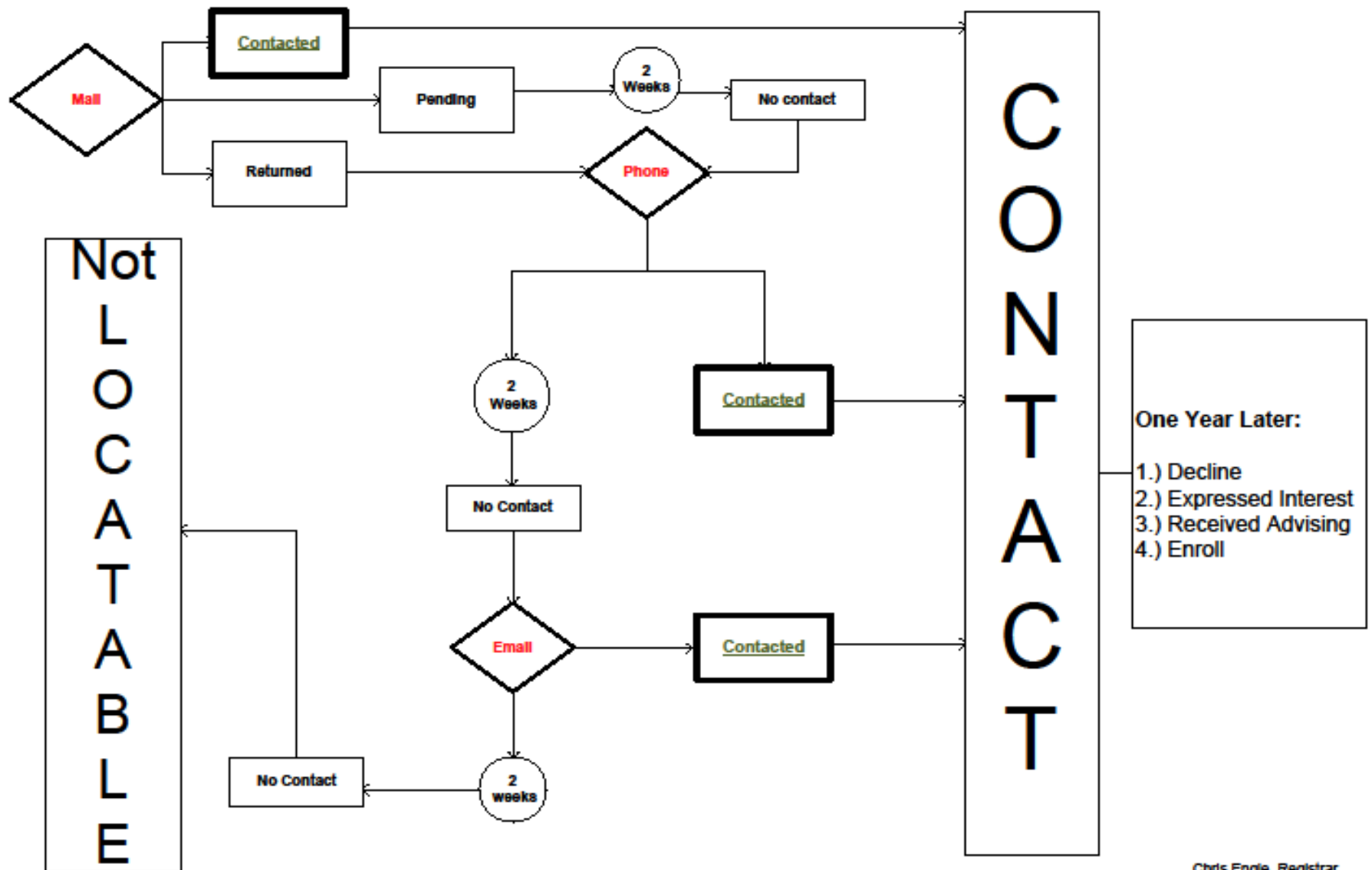


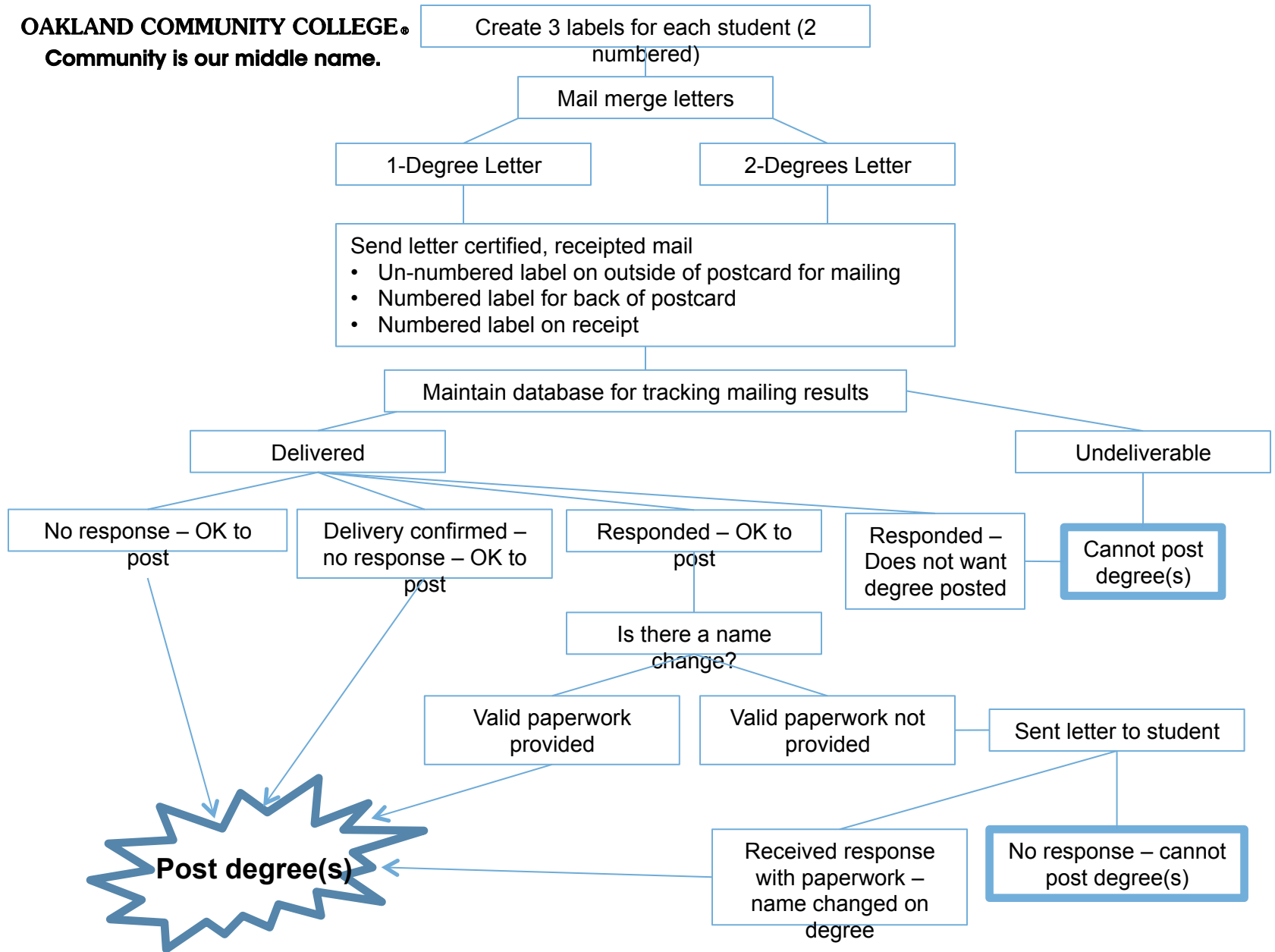
# College Reports
