

**AGREEMENT OF INTENT TO ENTER INTO
NEW JOBS TRAINING AGREEMENT**

The _____ Community College (the "College") and _____ (the "Employer") agree to pursue the development of a New Jobs Training Project pursuant to the New Jobs Training Programs codified in Chapter 13 of the Community College Act of 1966, Act 331, Public Acts of Michigan, 1966, as amended (the "Act"), effective as of the signing of this Agreement of Intent. The address where New Jobs will be located is:

Employer acknowledges that this Agreement of Intent is not a guarantee of project approval or project funding. Employer must execute a New Jobs Training Agreement that is approved by the College Board of Trustees. Such approval, if authorized, must be made within _____ days of the date of this Agreement of Intent (or such additional time as may be authorized by the Board of Trustees). **By entering into this Agreement of Intent, the College assumes no obligation or liability to the Employer. The Employer shall not make any claim or enter into any other action against the College, its Board of Trustees, officers, agents or employees, for any expense, damage or loss as a result of its activities with respect to this Agreement of Intent or the proposed training. The Employer understands that if it commences training prior to approval of a New Jobs Training Agreement by the College Board of Trustees, the Employer does so at its own risk and with no guarantee that costs incurred will be reimbursed by the College.**

The Employer hereby certifies that the number of jobs on its payroll in Michigan as of the date of this Agreement of Intent is _____, and that the highest number of jobs on its payroll in Michigan in the last 12 months was _____.

It is acknowledged by the Employer that jobs that existed prior to the signing of this Agreement of Intent may not be provided training pursuant to the Act.
