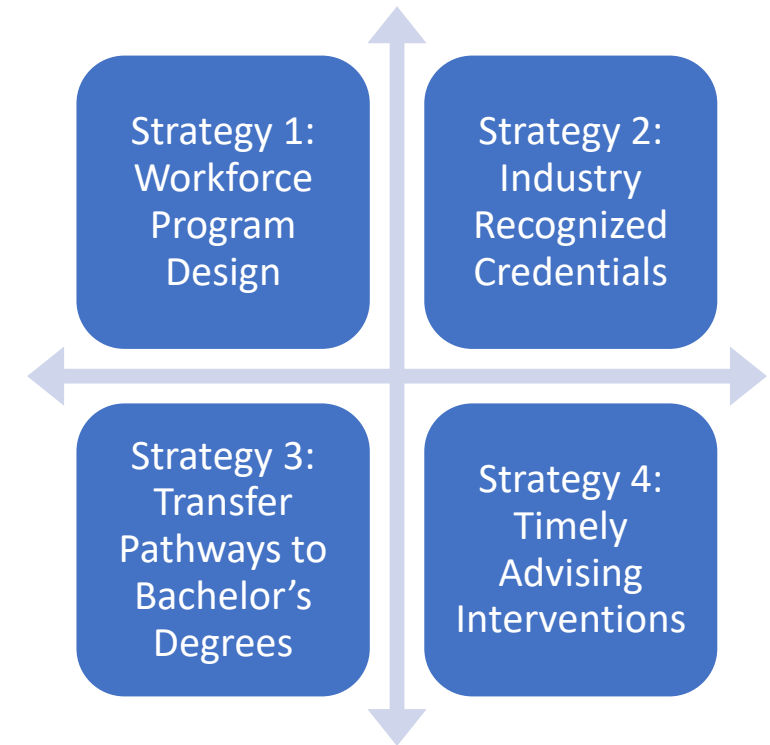


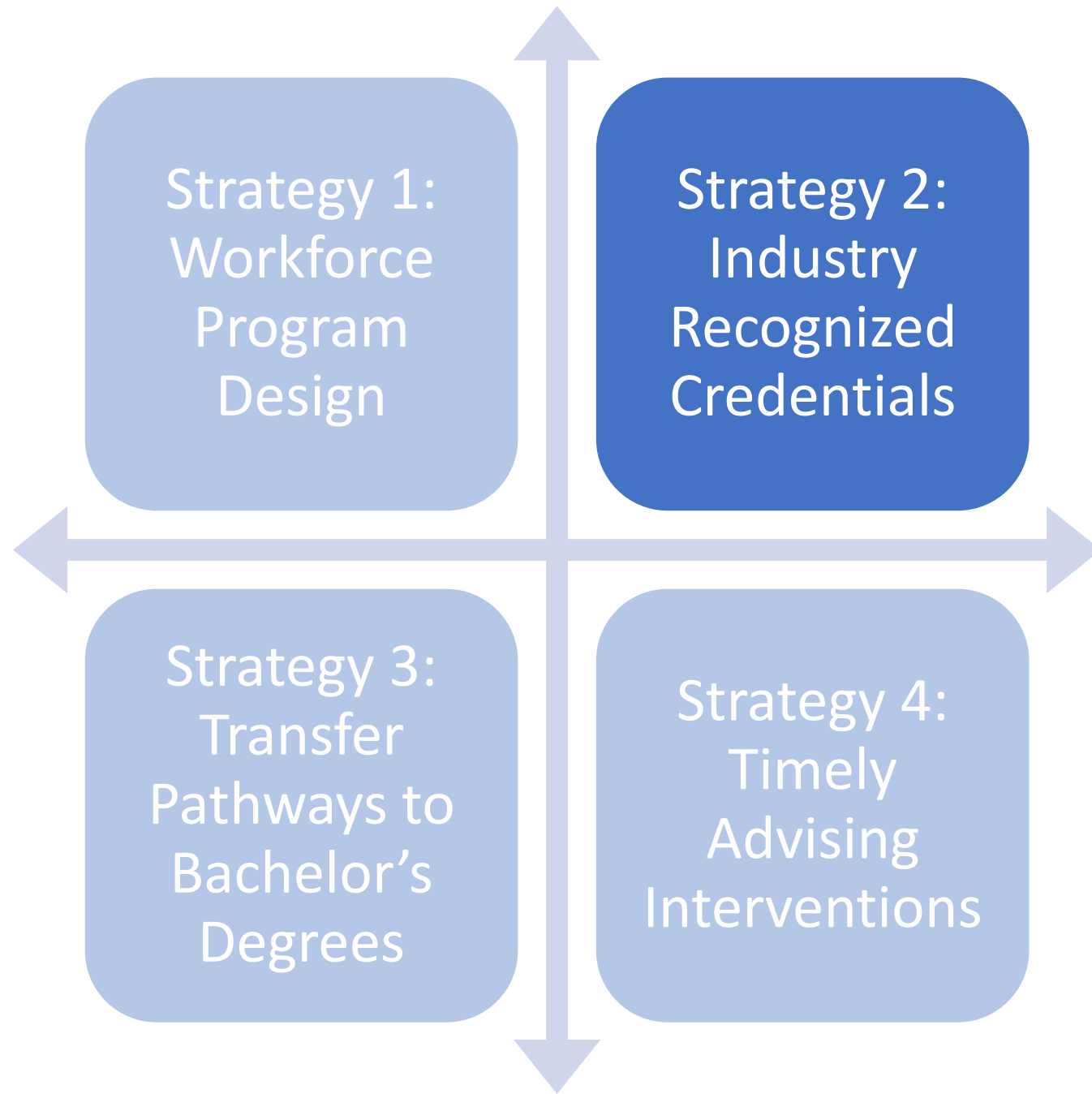



Launch Timeline: The new Michigan Transfer Network will launch on May 31, 2019. Please review the timeline below to ensure that your institution is ready for this launch. Tasks with an asterisk (*) require your attention. Please communicate with the appropriate staff on your campus to ensure that you can comply with the deadlines.

***Testing and Site Development (Today- April 29, 2019)**
Institutions can continue to upload test files to the course equivalency database and modify institutional information. Instructions to support these activities are on the Dashboard once you login to the site.

Migration to mitransfer.org (April 30, 2019)
The project team will clear the course equivalency database and close the development site on April 30, 2019 to ensure that we can go live with a fresh course equivalency database. The project team will begin the migration of the development site to mitransfer.org in preparation for the new site launch. Users should not access dev.mitransfer.org or mitransfer.org on April 30, 2019.

***Upload Final Course Equivalencies and Institutional Information (May 1-10, 2019)**
Institutions must upload a full set of course data and verify the accuracy of the institutional information between 8am on Wednesday, May 1, 2019 and Friday, May 10, 2019 at 5pm. **Look for instructions with a URL to upload data on May 1st.** Participating institutions **MUST** add course equivalencies and update institutional information between May 1 and May 10. Please begin to prepare for this window now and complete all 12 steps of the upload process including moving the data from Staging to Live. Instructions are available on the Dashboard once you login to the site.

Site Launch (May 31, 2019)
The new Michigan Transfer Network at www.mitransfer.org will launch on May 31, 2019. The current MTN at www.michigantransferrnetwork.org will redirect users to the new site.




